Therapet Emergency Pet Care Policy

The ACCM Emergency Pet Care Financial Assistance Fund has a limited non-renewable fund available for clients to access. Monies can be made available for reimbursement to clients of ACCM should they require Emergency Financial Assistance to cover some of the costs associated with emergency veterinary care. The policy for access to these funds is outlined in the following Emergency Pet Care Policy:

1. To be eligible you must be a registered client of ACCM and the pet must be registered with Therapet prior the emergency service date.
2. Reimbursement can be paid at 80% up to a ceiling amount of \$200.00 per calendar year per client (not per pet).
3. Appropriate documentation and official receipts will be required before any reimbursement can be processed.
4. Monies are limited for emergency care only and are not to be used for general maintenance, special diet requirements, vaccinations, injuries resulting from neglect or abuse, spaying or neutering.
5. ACCM in consultation with its in-house veterinarian reserves the right to decline applications for assistance.
